### What is a Practitioner?

"The one who attempts to heal oneself or another through a recognition of the ever availability of Good, is a mental or spiritual Practitioner. Such a one refuses to allow negative thought to control one's consciousness. One endeavors to greet the divinity in every being one meets."

The *professional* mental and spiritual Practitioner is one who has dedicated their life, time, energies and intelligence to helping others, through mental and spiritual means and methods."

### About your Practitioner session:

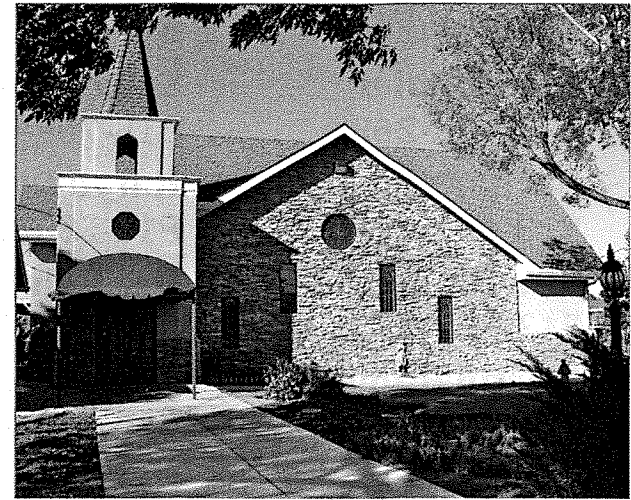
- Session lengths vary, but are typically one hour.
